DESCRIPTION

Prepcote Surface Treatment is a preventative treatment to inhibit the growth of moss, lichen or fungi - organic material that occurs on various substrates and surfaces.

USES

Apply to sound or weathered substrates prior to the application of the Primecote Sealer Primer.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Spray to noses of tiles and any fungi/mould affected areas with an atomising gun. Allow 4 hours to coating with the Primecote Sealer Primer. Please note that Prepcote Surface Treatment is not a cleaning product, it is to remain on the surface (do not rinse) to form part of the Globalcote system. Prepcote Surface Treatment may also be used as an anti-fungal preparation treatment to other external surfaces prior to painting.

NOTE: Do not apply where rain is imminent. High humidity may effect curing times. Weather conditions must be considered and deemed suitable before proceeding with application of the Globalcote system.

WARNING: If applying Prepcote by airless spray, ensure equipment is thoroughly flushed with water prior to proceeding with the application of Primecote.
